



Volunteer Position Information Sheet

Volunteers are key to the success of the annual Teen Business Challenge! Each volunteer position includes a time commitment, and some require some background experience. All volunteers will be a part of an orientation session prior to the event.

Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) – provide motivational speech to kick-off each round of the competition. Speech will be related to the different challenge subject areas (see event round descriptions).

Coaches – will coach one team through one round of the competition. It is expected that a round will require about 3 hours of the coach’s time plus preparation. Coaches can select which subject matter that they would like to coach based upon their skills, the day of the round and the time of the round (see schedule). Coaches will also be invited to attend a training session prior to the event.

Cyber Security/Coding Consultants –assist the teams with figuring out how to model their concept.

Judges – judge one round of the competition. Entrepreneurs and venture capitalists are strongly encouraged to apply!

Hosts – manage check-ins, guide visitors and contestants through the virtual event platform.
